***An Alternative to Pride Month***

This month for some time now has been designated “Pride Month.” It is not an official national designation, though the president in 1999 recognized it in an unofficial capacity. It is not necessary to go into detail with regard to it, but suffice it to say that it is a celebration of what God has designated as evil. In fact, the proponents of this “pride” celebration see this particular sin as something which calls for pride, as opposed to shame or embarrassment of any kind.

Now those who are Christians would certainly be opposed to any kind of celebration like this, because sin is nothing for which we should be proud.

Pride, however, is not something that is limited to any particular group of people. It is something to which we are all tempted, and which we all fall into, sometimes without really thinking about it. We may have pride in our abilities or skills. We may have a kind of pride that thinks that we are better than others. Our pride (as was sometimes evident in the Pharisees in the New Testament) may be founded on religious commitment. But whatever form it takes, pride is an affront to God. In fact, according to Proverbs 6:16-19, it is the first of the seven things that are listed as abominations to God - things which He hates.

With that in mind, it would be far better to designate June (and all months, for that matter) as “Humility Month.” And we already have a pattern for what this would look like in Scripture, specifically, 2 Chronicles 7:14.

“If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

What if each of us did this? What if each of us bowed before God each day of the month, admitting our known sin, and asking God to show us things in ourselves of which we are not aware that are not pleasing to Him, and pleading God’s help in turning from our sinful ways? He would certainly forgive. He promises that. And He may well bring salvation to our land.
